### Drawing Tools

***You need these for first day of class***

*Derwent* Graphite Pencils (6B, 4B, 2B, B)

*Staedtler Mars* or *Magic Rub* Eraser (one regular, one in pencil form)

***Make sure you have these by the end of the second week***

*Ebony* Pencils

*Kyra* Graphite Sticks (6B or softer)

Charcoal Pencils (2B, 4B)

*Conte* Compressed Charcoal Sticks (2B, 4B)

Kneaded Eraser

*Utrecht* Sumi Brush (round, size 4 & 6)

*Higgins* Drawing Ink (1 oz. bottle)
